

ROCKY RIDGE LANDFILL USERS

The Borough's goal for the burn box operation is to have effective combustion that does not pose a fire hazard or generate black smoke (air pollution).

Items that go into the burn unit must be strictly controlled to maintain a safe and effective operation. Each disposer must make sure their waste is segregated for recycling, burn box or landfill disposal.



The following guidelines should be followed for segregating your household waste at home before bringing it to the landfill to maximize the amount that can be burned and make sure all activities are performed safely.

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Paper (newspaper, office paper, paperboard, non-glossy magazines, cardboard),
- General household refuse (food scraps, garbage bags, product packaging, tin cans)
- Small pieces of wood
- Natural fiber rope
- Wax coated fish boxes
- Food cans

UNACCEPTABLE BURN BOX ITEMS

- Hazardous waste
- Aerosol cans
- Batteries of any type
- Plastics (pipe, beverage & laundry soap containers)
- Glass
- Propane bottles
- Shrink wrap
- Carpet
- Tires or other rubber products
- Scrap metal
- Treated wood
- Electronics
- Appliances
- Junk Vehicles
- Diapers
- Synthetic fish nets & rope
- Foam/Styrofoam packaging
- Building materials (insulation, wiring, drywall, plumbing)

The RRL has a stockpile are for large items such as wood, pallets, brush, and landclearing debris that is open burned on an as needed basis.

RECYCLE BIN

Aluminum cans and PETE #1 and HDPE #2 plastics can be recycled. Plastics have the numerical recycle category molded into the bottom of the containers to verify that the type of plastic you have is acceptable. All other plastics should be disposed in the landfill.
